## VPK

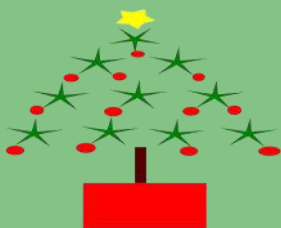
This month we will continue learn about different features on clothes, how to care for clothes and how clothes are made. We will also be learning about the season of winter and exploring nature.
